Independent

The Commission is an independent body established by Parliament under the Criminal Appeal Act 1995.

Impartial

Each application is reviewed impartially to decide whether or not it should be referred to the relevant appeal court.

Thorough

The Commission carries out thorough reviews of convictions and sentences in alleged and suspected miscarriages of justice.

Open

The Commission is as open as possible about its policies and processes; applicants are given reasons for decisions

Accountable

The Commission is accountable to the public, through Parliament, for its performance.
